## <u>Oakley Junior School's</u> <u>Acceptable use of Internet Agreement</u>



In a world where technology is advancing far beyond our wildest imaginations, we have to be constantly reflecting on how these gadgets can influence our behaviour and how to be safe using them. At Oakley Junior School, we think it is important to unpick how we can all be responsible for our actions when online to help us be safe.

When ever you use any device or gadget that can connect to the internet, you are likely to be 'online'.

- I will make sure that I only use the **websites** I have been told to use.
- I will not deliberately look for, save or send anything that could be unpleasant or nasty. If I
  accidentally find anything like this, I will tell an adult immediately. I will make sure I only search for
  things that I have been told to search for.
- I will **not damage** any technology and treat it with care. If I spot any damage, I will inform an adult.
- I will try my hardest to spot advertisements, **scams** and pop ups so that I do not click on them.
- I will be critical of the information I see online (**not everything** you see online is true).
- I will keep my passwords safe (not tell other people) and only log in to things using my account so long as I have permission from an adult.
- I will make sure I **do not talk to strangers** online.
- I will make sure I **do not share information** like my phone number, pictures or information about me with the online world.
- I will **think carefully before I accept** any friend requests or group chat requests. Do I know them? Am I putting myself at risk?
- I will think carefully about whether the things I am saying/ doing online could hurt someone's feelings.
- If something happens that bothers me, upsets me or that I'm not sure about, I will tell an adult.
- I will be responsible for my own actions when I'm online and constantly ask myself if what I am doing is safe and kind towards others.
