


In all the units of Science, the children will develop skills in working scientifically.





Key Stage 3

Children are taught in biology about different types of cells (including how these are structured) and the different systems of the human body, focusing on reproduction in more detail. In Chemistry, children learn about the periodic table (including how elements are grouped and how to separate different chemicals and materials. In Physics, children learn in more detail about light and sound waves and forces and begin to look at particles.
