

Anglo-Saxons and Vikings

Maths: We will start with number and place value to include 4-digit numbers. We will then build upon the different operations to develop formal written methods.

We will also be studying measurement and recapping multiplication and division.

English: We will be reading stories with historical settings and we will be writing an adventure narrative based on the Anglo-Saxon tale of Beowulf.

RE: The children will be exploring the Qur'an and its importance to the Islamic faith.

Art: We will study Viking brooches and their designs. We will then design and make our own brooches.

French: We will be learning how to present our selves, including how to explain how old we are and our nationality.

Music: Duration, dynamics and tempo. We will compose our own pieces of music to re-tell Beowulf.

Science: We will be learning about how sounds are made and how most of them are linked to vibrations.

DT: We will use wood to design and make a rotary photo frames.

PSHE: We will look at what community means and what communities we belong to.

History: Our history will focus on the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings. Who were they? Where did they come from? What did they change in Britain?

PE: We will have two PE lessons each week: gymnastics and football.

Computing: We will continue to develop our digital literacy skills using Microsoft Word.
