Writing

History

We will be finding out about the Stone, Bronze and Iron age periods of history and asking, 'Which was the best age to live in?'

DT

We will be designing and making comfortable trousers for Ug a Stone age child.

Maths

We will continue to add and subtract three-digit numbers and represent this in different ways. We will be looking at turns and angles and the vocabulary of simple geometry.

Religious Education

We will be asking; Why does Christmas matter to Christians? You are invited to our Carol Service at school on Tuesday 16th December.

PE

In Gymnastics we will be developing our balancing, rolling and jumping. We will be combining these to create short sequences. In outdoor PE we will be doing orienteering in our school grounds to develop our gross-motor and geographical skills.

Science

We will be learning to compare and group different rocks. We will describe how fossils are formed and recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.
