

PE

In P.E. we will be improving their balancing and controlled movements in gymnastics.

The children will also be improving their teamwork and invasion game skills throughout football.

French

In French this term, the children will be continuing with the topic of 'Presenting myself' and begin to have more independent conversations.

English

This term, we will also be reading the book 'Sky Hawk' by Gill Lewis. Tasked with creating a factual poster about ospreys, the children will have to apply their knowledge of non-fiction writing as well as engaging their audience. We will then be summarising plot lines, writing character descriptions and looking closely at how writers create tension and suspense.

Maths

In Maths this term, we will recap what we have learnt from year 5 about fractions and move onto more challenging questions that require the children to manipulate fractions and answer worded problems. To end the half term, we will be looking at converting between units of measure. We will be continuing to develop the children's rapid recall of number facts including rapid recall of times table and division facts.

Geography

This half term, we will be looking at Ukraine and how we as a country trade. Also, we will be exploring the ways in which we farm in England and see this live in action during our farm school trip!

RE

In R.E this term, our theme is incarnation where we will be considering the question: More than the Messiah—Son of God?

Music

In Music, the children will be exploring the unit 'Calypso Sparkle' where they will be exploring the dimensions of music, particularly pitch and texture.

Year 6 - Autumn 2

Science

Our topic this term is Electricity. We will be looking at controlling electrical circuits, creating switches and ensuring that we use a range of scientific vocabulary. We will then apply what we have learnt to conduct an experiment where we have to work scientifically.

PSHE

Throughout the half term, children will be looking at what makes a good friend and how best to nurture new friendships. Children will be continuing on from the 'Emotions day' work by reflecting on themselves and the feelings they experience within social situations. This term we will also have Anti-bullying week.

Computing

In Computing, we will be moving on to creating spreadsheets using Excel. The children will apply the basic formulae they learnt in Year 5 to more complex instructions for example conditional formatting. They will then make links with real-life applications.

DT

In design technology this half term, we will be applying what we have learnt in science about electricity and circuits to debug and create our own circuit containing a motor. We will use computer aided design (Blender software) to help us think carefully about the structure of a wooden buggy. Throughout the unit, we will be drawing on many skills including problem solving and applying what we know about the great inventors of the first motorised vehicle.
